

# Christmas Set

## Crochet pattern

Hello there!! Thanks for trying my pattern. I'm sure that you love this set! You can always ask me if you have any questions. Please read our explanations well. Enjoy it!

### MATERIAL:

Yarn Art Jeans – 01 (white)

Yarn Art Jeans – 52 (green)

Yarn Art jeans – 90 (red)

Yarn Art jeans – 88 (yellow)

Yarn Art jeans – 03 (milk)

Yarn Art jeans – 71 (brown)

Yarn Art jeans – 75 (blue)

Alize Baby Softy – 62 (white)

Sewing thread – black, white, red

Hook – 2.5mm

Small black beads for eyes – 6 items

White beads for decoration – 8 items

Lace - 180cm

Pompons – 3 items

**We also need:** scissors, needle with a wide eye, filler.

### SIZE:

Approx. 20cm (with the hanging and the bow)

### ABBREVIATIONS:

**sc:** single crochet

**ch:** chain

**rnd:** round

**mr:** magic ring

**slst:** slip stitch

**inc:** increase (2 single crochet in same stitch)

**∗:** repeat instructions “x” times

### Santa Claus:

Use red, white and beige yarn. Begin with red yarn.

Rnd 1- 6sc in a mr

Rnd 2-(6inc)=12sc

Rnd3 = 12sc

Rnd4 – 1inc, 5sc, 1inc, 5sc = 14sc

Rnd5 = 14sc

Rnd6 – 1inc, 6sc, 1inc, 6sc = 16sc

Rnd7 = 16sc

Rnd8 – 1inc, 7sc, 1inc, 7sc = 18sc

Rnd9 = 18sc

Rnd10 – 1inc, 8sc, 1inc, 8sc = 20sc

→Embroider small snowflakes with white sewing thread.



→Change the yarn. Use fluffy yarn.

Rnd11 = 20sc



→Change yarn. Use beige yarn.

Rnd12 – 1inc, 9sc, 1inc, 9sc = 22sc

Rnd13 = 22sc

Rnd14 – 1inc, 10sc, 1inc, 10sc = 24sc

Rnd15 = 24sc



→Sew the pompon. I used special pompons but you can make it yourself.

→Sew the eyes (black beads) between the 14<sup>th</sup> and the 15<sup>th</sup> rounds.



→Change the yarn. Use red and white yarn. Begin with red yarn.

Rnd16 – 1inc, 12sc, 1inc, and 12sc with white yarn

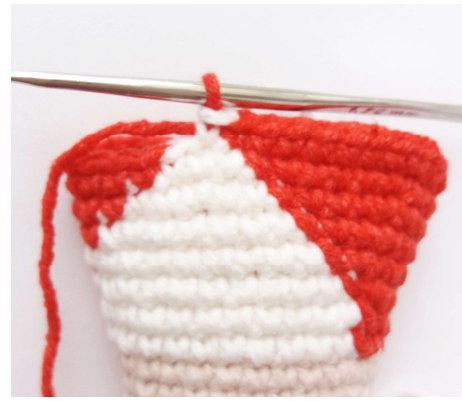


→When you reach red stitches change yarn. Grab red thread from the other side leaving long thread which you take into the crocheting. Hide this thread behind the stitches while crocheting with red yarn. You need make these actions with white yarn too.





- Rnd17 - 14sc with red yarn, 12sc with white yarn  
 Rnd18 - (1inc, 12sc, 1inc, 1sc with red yarn), 10sc with white yarn  
 Rnd19 - 19sc with red yarn, 9sc with white yarn  
 Rnd20 - (2sc, 1inc, 13sc, 3sc with red yarn), 7sc with white yarn  
 Rnd21 - 24sc with red yarn, 5sc with white yarn  
 Rnd22 - (5sc, 1inc, 14sc, 1inc, 5sc with red yarn), 3sc with white yarn  
 Rnd23 - 30sc with red yarn, 1sc with white yarn  
 Rnd24 - 8sc, 1inc, 15sc, 1inc, 7sc with red yarn



→Break white yarn and fasten it off.

Rnd25 = 34sc with red yarn

Rnd26 - 1inc, 16sc, 1inc, 16sc = 36sc

Rnd27 = 36sc

Don't break the yarn.

→Make mustache with fluffy yarn. Take the needle with big eye and thread the yarn. Make some stitches on the 17rnd on the left and on the right sides in turn. Don't tighten threads. Then make a knot and fasten it off.





→Then cut fluffy thread long 10cm. Make a not in the middle of the mustache. Then fasten it off.

→Embroider the snowflakes.



→Stuff it. Then fold the sides and connect them with slst.





→Finish crocheting. Break yarn and fasten it off.



→Take lace 20cm long and pull it through the top of the head with the needle. Make a knot.



→Take lace 25cm long and pull it through the bottom of the body. Make a bow. Then thread white beads and make knots on the ends of the lace.



### Christmas tree:

Use green, red, white yarn. Begin with green yarn.

Rnd 1- 6sc in a mr

Rnd 2-(6inc)=12sc

Rnd3 = 12sc

Rnd4 – 1inc, 5sc, 1inc, 5sc = 14sc

Rnd5 = 14sc

Rnd6 – 1inc, 6sc, 1inc, 6sc = 16sc

Rnd7 = 16sc

Rnd8 – 1inc, 7sc, 1inc, 7sc = 18sc

Rnd9 = 18sc

Rnd10 – 1inc, 8sc, 1inc, 8sc = 20sc

Change yarn. Use red yarn.

Don't break green yarn. We will use it in turn.



Rnd11 – 20sc

Don't break red yarn. We will use it in turn. Use green yarn.



Rnd12 - 1inc, 9sc, 1inc, 9sc = 22sc

Change yarn. Use white yarn. Don't break red yarn.

We will use it in turn.

Rnd13 = 22sc

Change yarn. Use green yarn.

Rnd14 – 1inc, 10sc, 1inc, 10sc = 24sc

Change yarn. Use red yarn.

Rnd15 = 24sc

Change yarn. Use green yarn.

Rnd16 – 1inc, 11sc, 1inc, 11sc = 26sc

Change yarn. Use white yarn.

Rnd17 = 26sc

Change yarn. Use green yarn.

Rnd18 – 1inc, 12sc, 1inc, 12sc = 28sc

Change yarn. Use red yarn.

Rnd19 = 28sc

Change yarn. Use green yarn.

Rnd20 – 1inc, 13sc, 1inc, 13sc = 30sc

Change yarn. Use white yarn.

Rnd21 = 30sc

Change yarn. Use green yarn.

Rnd22 – 1inc, 14sc, 1inc, 14sc = 32sc

Change yarn. Use red yarn.

Rnd23 = 32sc

Change yarn. Use green yarn.

Rnd24 – 1inc, 15sc, 1inc, 15sc = 34sc

Change yarn. Use white yarn.

Rnd25 = 34sc

Change yarn. Use green yarn. Break red and white yarn and fasten them off.

Rnd26 – 1inc, 16sc, 1inc, 16sc = 36sc

Rnd27 = 36sc

→ Stuff it. Then fold the sides and connect them with slst.



→Finish crocheting. Break yarn and fasten it off.



→Sew the pompon. I used special pompons but you can make it yourself.



→Take lace 20cm long and pull it through the top of the head with the needle. Make a knot.



→Take lace 25cm long and pull it through the bottom of the body. Make a bow. Then thread white beads and make knots on the ends of the lace.



The Christmas tree is ready!
