

AMIGURUMI BABY COW PATTERN



- Thank you for supporting us. Before you start, you should carefully read what you need to know and the tools to prepare. Any changes for larger/smaller sizes will be indicated at the start of each pattern piece.

Material

- Yarn: Bernat: #5 Bulky Yarn
- Color: Pink, Black, Brown, and White color
- 3.5mm (E) Hook
- Stitch marker
- Sewing needle
- Scissors
- Plastic safety eyes
- Hot gun glue
- Fiberfill

Abbreviations

- MR : Magic Ring
- st(s) : stitch(es)
- sl st : slip stitch
- sk : skip
- ch: chain
- SC : single crochet
- INC : Increase
- BLO : back loop only
- DEC : Decrease

This is the instruction for crocheting amigurumi
with a size ~45cmX18cm (~17.7INChx7INCh)

HEAD:

Begin with white yarn:

change the yarn color according to the font color

- Row 1: 6 SC in an MR (6)
- Row 2: INC 6 times (12)
- Row 3: (SC, INC) 6 times (18)
- Row 4: (2SC, INC) 6 times (24)
- Row 5: (3SC, INC) 3 times, **3 SC, INC**, (3SC, INC) 2 times (30)
- Row 6: (4SC, INC) 2 times, 4SC, **INC, 4SC, INC**, (4SC, INC) 2 times (36)
- Row 7: (5SC, INC) 2 times, 3SC, **2SC, INC, 5SC, INC**, (5SC, INC) 2 times (42)
- Row 8: (6SC, INC) 2 times, 3SC, **3SC, INC, 6SC, INC**, (6SC, INC) 2 times (48)
- Row 9: 19SC, **13SC**, 16SC (48)
- Row 10: 21SC, **10SC**, 17SC (48)
- Row 11: 22SC, **8SC**, 18SC (48)
- Row 12: 48SC (48)
- Row 13: 4SC, **5SC**, 39SC (48)
- Row 14: 3SC, **7SC**, 38SC (48)
- Row 15: 3SC, **(INC, 3SC) 2 times**,
INC, (3SC, INC) 9 times (60)
- Row 16: 2SC, **13SC**, 45SC (60)
- Row 17-18: **15SC**, 45SC (60)
- Row 19: SC, **12SC**, 47SC (60)
- Row 20: 3SC, **9SC**, 48SC (60)
- Row 21: (3SC, DEC) 12 times (48)
- Row 22: (4SC, DEC) 8 times (40)
- Row 23: (3SC, DEC) 8 times (32)
- Row 24: (2SC, DEC) 8 times (24)
- Row 25: (SC, DEC) 8 times (16)
- Row 26: DEC 8 times (8)



stuffing

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing 6BLO sts together

MUZZLE:

Use Pink yarn

Make 8 chain, starting in the second chain from the hook. Working on both sides of a chain (working on the foundation chain)

- Row 1: INC, 5SC, 4SC into the last stitch, continue the other side of the foundation chain: 5SC, INC (18)
- Row 2: 2INC, 5SC, 4INC, 5SC, 2INC (26)
- Row 3: (SC, INC) 2 times, 5SC, (SC, INC) 4 times, 5SC, (SC, INC) 2 times (34)
- Row 4-5: 34SC (34)

stuffing

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing the muzzle to the head on R14-21.

EARS (Make 2):

- Row 1: 6SC in an MR (6)
- Row 2: 6 INC (12)
- Row 3: (SC, INC) 6 times (18)
- Row 4: (2SC, INC) 6 times (24)
- Row 5-6: 24SC (24)
- Row 7: (6 SC, DEC) 3 times (21)
- Row 8-9: 21SC (21)
- Row 10: (5SC, DEC) 3 times (19)

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Horn (Make 2):

- Row 1: 6SC in an MR (6)
- Row 2: (SC, INC) 3 times (9)
- Row 3: 9SC (9)
- Row 4: (2SC, INC) 3 times (12)
- Row 5: 12SC (12)
- Row 6: (3SC, INC) 3times (15)

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.



TIME TO ATTACH THEM TO THE HEAD

Sew the muzzle to the head



Sew the horn to the head



Sew the ears to the head



Attach eyes and sew the nose



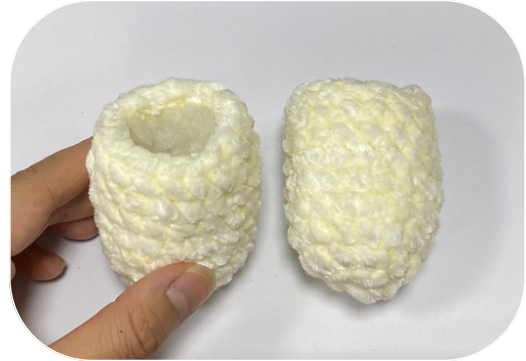
ARMS (Make 2):

Use White yarn

- Row 1: 6SC in an MR (6)
- Row 2: 6INC (12)
- Row 3: (SC, INC) 6 times (18)
- Row 4-10: 18SC (18)

stuffing

Fasten off and cut the yarn.



LEGS (Make 2):

Use White yarn

change the yarn color according to the font color

- Row 1: 6SC in MR (6)
- Row 2: 6INC (12)
- Row 3: (SC, INC) 6 times (18)
- Row 4: (2SC, INC) 6 times (24)
- Row 5: 4SC, **5SC**, 15SC (24)
- Row 6: 3SC, **5SC**, 16SC (24)
- Row 7: 2SC, DEC, **2SC**, DEC, (2SC, DEC) 4 times (18)
- Row 8-10: 18SC (18)

stuffing

Make one more leg until round 10 but DO NOT cut the yarn.



BODY:

Begin with White yarn

- Make chain 5 : seamless leg Join
- Row 1: 18SC of the first leg, 5SC of the chain, 18SC of the second leg, 5SC on back bump of the chains between 2 legs (46)
- Row 2: 18SC, INC, 3SC, INC, 23SC (48)
- Row 3: 12SC, INC, (3SC, INC) 5 times, 15SC (54)
- Row 4: 13 SC, **7SC**, 34SC (54)
- Row 5: 12SC, **9SC**, 33SC (54)
- Row 6: 9SC, INC, (**4SC, INC**) 2 times, (4SC, INC) 3 times, 19SC (60)
- Row 7: 11SC, **12SC**, 37SC (60)
- Row 8: 12SC, **10SC**, 38SC (60)
- Row 9: 13SC, **9SC**, 31SC, 7SC (60)
- Row 10: 51SC, **9SC** (60)
- Row 11: **3SC**, 48SC, **9SC** (60)
- Row 12: **3SC**, 49SC, **8SC** (60)
- Row 13: **3SC**, 5SC, DEC, 39SC, DEC, SC, **8SC** (58)
- Row 14: **3SC**, 4SC, DEC, 39SC, DEC, **8SC** (56)
- Row 15: **3SC**, 3SC, DEC, 39SC, DEC, 7SC (54)
- Row 16: 54SC (54)
- Row 17: 30SC, **10SC**, 14SC (54)
- Row 18: 29SC, **12SC**, 13SC (54)
- Row 19: 28SC, **14SC**, 12SC (54)
- Row 20: 27SC, **15SC**, 12SC (54)
- Row 21: 26SC, **16SC**, 12SC (54)
- Row 22: 10SC, DEC, (5SC, DEC) 2 times, (**5SC, DEC**) 2 times, **2SC**, 3SC, **DEC**, 7SC (48)



- Row 23: 23SC, **14SC**, 11SC (48)
- Row 24: 23SC, **13SC**, 12SC (48)
- Row 25: 24SC, **11SC**, 13SC (48)
- Row 26: 12SC, (3SC, DEC) 6 times, 6SC (42)
- Row 27-28: 42SC (42)
- Row 29: 8SC, 6SC of the first arm, 20SC, 6SC of the second arm, 2SC (42)
- Row 30: 8SC, 12SC of the first arm, 20SC, 12SC of the second arm, 2SC (54)
- Row 31: 54SC (54)
- Row 32: 14SC, (3SC, DEC) 6 times, 10SC (48)
- Row 33: 48SC (48)
- Row 34: 14SC, (2SC, DEC) 6 times, 10SC (42)
- Row 35: 42SC (42)

stuffing

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.



Sew the head to the body

stuffing



TAIL: Begin with White yarn

- Row 1: 5SC (5)
- Row 2: 5INC (10)
- Row 3: (SC, INC) 5 times (15)
- Row 4: 4SC, **3SC**, 8SC
- Row 5: 3SC, **4SC**, 8SC (12)
- Row 6: 5SC, **3SC**, 7SC (12)
- Row 7-12: 12SC

stuffing

- Row 13: 10SC, **5SC** (15)
- Row 14-15: 8SC, **7SC** (15)
- Row 16-23: 15SC (15)

Fasten off and leave along tail for sewing close two side of the tail together.

Sew the tail to the body R8
