**What will you need:**

Red heart Super saver Jumbo yarn – buffalo color  
Red heart Super saver yarn – cafe latte color for darker parts  
I made really big – real size dog with that yarn.

Or you can use any yarn you would like to use.

Just remember: heavier yarn will give you bigger toy, lighter – smaller.

Use yarn weight #2 or smaller to get smaller dog.

**TIP 1:** Always use smaller hook than it is written on yarn. That way we avoid big “holes” and fiber will not go out from toy.

Crochet hook: 4mm (US G6)

Safety eyes: brown, 20 mm diameter (I bought mine at JoAnn shop)

We need for nose oven – baked clay or you can buy plastic. You will need more than 1” width size.

Synthetic fiber

Some Super Glue (I use Gorilla)

Abbreviations:

Sc –single crochet

Hdc – half double crochet

Dc – double crochet

Dec -2sc together –single crochet decrease

inc – crochet 2sc in 1 stitch -single crochet increase

Work on front loop only (you can watch this video if you do not know how to make it):

**EARS (make two pieces):**

Dark brown yarn

In amigurumi ring make 5 sc

**Round 1:** (inc) x 5 times (10)

**Round 2:** 10sc (10)

**Round 3:** (1sc, inc) x 5 times (15)

**Round 4:** (2sc, inc) x 5 times (20)

**Round 5:** (3sc, inc) x 5 times (25)

**Round 6:** 25 sc (25)

**Round 7:** (4sc, inc) x 5 times (30)

**Round 8-10:** 30sc (30)

**Row 11:** crochet both edges together – 15sc (15)



**Row 12-13:** 15sc (15)

Change yarn to light color

**Row 14:** 7 dc, 8 sc (15)

**Row 15:** 8 sc, 7ds (15)

**FRONT LEGS** (make two pieces):

In amigurumi ring make 6sc

**Round 1:** (inc) x 6 times (12)

**Round 2:** (1sc, inc) x 6 times (18)

**Round 3:** (2sc, inc) x 6 times (24)

**Round 4:** (3sc, inc) x 6 times (30)

**Round 5-11:** 30sc (30)

**Round 12:** (4sc, dec) x 5 times (25)

**Round 13:** 25sc (25) put in fiber

**Round 14:** 25sc (25)

Now we are going to separate feet from leg, so paws can be moveable.  
Take needle with yarn and sew lightly both edges together.



**Round 15:** 12sc, 13dc (25)

**Round 16-20:** 25sc (25)

**Round 21:** 12sc, inc, 11sc, inc (27)

**Round 22-26:** 27sc (27sc)

**Round 27:** 12sc, inc, 13sc, inc (29)

**Round 28-32:** 29sc (29)

**Round 33:** 14sc, inc, 14sc (30)

**Round 34:** 30sc (30)

**Round 35-36:** 7sc, 16dc, 7sc (30)

For second leg:

**Row 35-36:** 8dc, 14sc, 8dc (30)



**#To join legs to body:** those leg's sides with dc should be on the sides.

## Head + Body + Tale (one part)

Darker yarn

In amigurumi ring make 6 sc

**Round 1:** (inc) x 6 times (12)

**Round 2:** (1sc, inc) x 6 times (18)

**Round 3:** (2sc, inc) x 6 times (24)

**Round 4:** (3sc, inc) x 6 times (30)

**Round 5:** (4sc, inc) x 6 times (36)

**Round 6:** (5sc, inc) x 6 times (42)

**Round 7:** (6sc, inc) x 6 times (48)

**Round 8:** (7sc, inc) x 6 times (54)

**Round 9:** 8sc, inc, (1dc, dcinc) x4 times, (inc, 8sc) x2 times, inc, (1dc, dcinc) x4 times, inc, 8sc, inc(68)

**Round 10:** 68sc (68)

**Round 11:** 3sc, dec x 2 times, 54sc, dec x 2 times, 3sc (64)

**Round 12-13:** 64sc (64)

Change yarn to light color

**Round 14:** 13sc, 38hdc -Work on front loop only, 13sc (64)

**Round 15-17:** 13sc, 38hdc, 13sc (64)

**Round 18:** 13sc, 38sc – crochet two rows 18 and 14 together, 13sc (64)

Look on the pictures under how to crochet two rows together. When we crochet two rows together, we are making wrinkles for dog.



**Round 19:** 12sc, (3sc, inc) x10 times, 12sc (74)

**Round 20:** 12hdc - Work on front loop only, (4sc, inc) x 3times, 4sc, (3dc in 1sc) x 3 times, 6sc, (3dc in 1sc) x 3 times, 4sc, (inc, 4sc) x 3 times, 12hdc -Work on front loop only (92)

**Round 21:** 12dc, 68sc, 12dc (92)

**Round 22:** 12dc, 22sc, 3dc together x 3 times, 6sc, 3dc together x 3 times, 22sc, 12dc (80)

**Round 23:** 12dc, (1sc, inc) x 3 times, 19hdc - Work on front loop only, 6sc, 19hdc- Work on front loop only, (1sc, inc) x 3 times, 12dc (86)

**Round 24:** 12hdc, 9sc, 19hdc, 6sc, 19hdc, 9sc, 12hdc (86)

**Round 25:** 12sc -(crochet row 20 and row 25 together), 9sc, 19hdc, 6sc, 19hdc, 9sc, 12sc -(crochet row 20 and row 25 together) (86)

**Round 26:** 21sc, 19hdc, 2sc, inc x 2 times, 2sc, 19hdc, 21sc (88)

**Round 27:** (1sc, inc) x 5 times, 11sc, 19sc (crochet row 23 and row 27 together), 2sc, (3sc in 1sc) x 4 times, 2sc, 19sc (crochet row 23 and row 27 together), 11sc, (1sc, inc) x 5 times (106)

**Round 28:** 12hdc -Work on front loop only, 20sc, (1sc, inc) x 7 times, 14sc, (1sc, inc) x 7 times, 20sc, 12hdc -Work on front loop only (120)

**Round 29:** 12hdc, 96sc, 12hdc (120)

**Round 30:** 12hdc, 25sc, 10dc -Work on front loop only, 26sc, 10dc- Work on front loop only, 25sc, 12hdc (120)

**Round 31:** 12hdc, 25sc, 10dc, 26sc, 10dc, 25sc, 12hdc (120)

**Round 32:** 12sc -(crochet row28 and 32 together), 25sc, 10sc (crochet row30 and 32 together), 26sc, 10sc (crochet row 30 and 32 together), 25sc, 12sc (crochet row 28 and 32 together) (120)

**Round 33:** 12sc, (3sc, dec) x 5 times, 17sc, 3dc together x 4 times, 17sc, (3sc, dec) x 5 times, 12sc (102)

**Round 34:** 49sc, dec x 2 times, 49sc (100)

Now you have made 3 vertical wrinkles, hold each by fingers and sew them from inside

What you have to have:

**Round 35:** (1sc, inc) x 10times, 60sc, (1sc, inc) x 10times (120)

Now we are going to attach ears to head. Ear's side with dc attach to head's middle.

**Round 36:** (5sc, inc) x 5times, 7sc, 15sc - (crochet head with ears together: 15sc from head + 15sc from ear), 16sc, 15sc-(crochet head with ears together: 15sc from head + 15sc from ear), 7sc, (5sc, inc) x 5 times (130)

**Round 37:** 50sc, (1sc, dec) x 10 times, 50sc (120)

**Round 38:** 30hdc - Work on front loop only, 60sc, 30hdc -Work on front loop only (120)

**Round 39:** 30hdc, 60sc, 30hdc (120)

**Round 40:** 30hdc, 12sc, 1sc from ear + 1sc from head together, 34sc, second ear-1sc from ear + 1sc from head together, 12sc, 30hdc (120)



**Round 41:** 30hdc, 60sc, 30hdc (120)

**Round 42:** 30sc- (crochet row 38 and row 42 together), 60sc, 30sc -(crochet row 38 and row 42 together) (120)

**Round 43:** 25sc, (dec, 3sc) x 4 times, 30sc, (dec, 3sc) x 4 times, 25sc (112)

**Round 44-45:** 112sc (112)

**Round 46:** 42sc, (2sc, dec) x 7times. 42sc (105)

**Round 47:** 105sc (105)

**Round 48:** (3sc, dec) x 3 times, 23sc, (3sc, inc) x 7 times, 23sc, (3sc, dec) x 3 times (104)

**Round 49:** 104sc (104)

**Round 50:** (4sc, inc) x 3 times, 74sc, (4sc, inc) x 3 times (110)

**Round 51-52:** 110sc (110)

**Round 53:** 6sc, 17hdc- Work on front loop only, 64sc, 17hdc -Work on front loop only, 6sc (110)

**Round 54:** 6sc, 17hdc, 64sc, 17hdc, 6sc (110)

**Round 55:** 6cs, 17sc (crochet row 53 and row 55 together), 64sc, 17sc (crochet row 53 and row 55 together), 6sc (110)

**Round 56:** 6sc, 15sc (crochet together body + half of leg), 68sc, 15sc (crochet together body + half of leg), 6sc (110)

Be careful, attach legs right!!!

Look on the picture.

Put fiber into both legs, can put wire into legs to help him stand better.



**Round 57:** 6cs, 15sc (crochet through the rest of leg), dec x 2 times, 60sc, dec x 2 times, 15sc (crochet through the rest of leg), 6sc (106)



Round 58-59: 106sc (106)

Attach eyes (skip 3-4 sc from wrinkle).

**TIP 2:** I put little piece white felted fabric under each eyes and cut around eyes like 1mm, so eyes can look more realistic.



**Round 60:** (2sc, inc) x 5 times, 18sc, (2sc, dec) x 10times, 18sc, (2sc, inc) x 5 times (106)

**Round 61 - 65:** 106sc (106)

**Round 66:** (2sc, inc) x 5 times, 18sc, (2sc, dec) x 10times, 18sc, (2sc, inc) x 5 times (106)

**Round 67-71:** 106sc (106)

**Round 72:** (2sc, inc) x 5 times, 18sc, (2sc, dec) x 10times, 18sc, (2sc, inc) x 5 times (106)

**Round 73-77:** 106sc (106)

**Round 78:** (2sc, dec) x 5 times, 66sc, (2sc, dec) x 5 times (96)

**Round 79-80:** 96sc (96)  
**Round 81:** (2sc, dec) x 5 times, 56sc, (2sc, dec) x 5 times (86)  
**Round 82-85:** 86sc (86)  
**Round 86:** 16sc, (4sc, dec) x 9 times, 16sc (77)  
**Round 87-89:** 77sc (77)  
**Round 90:** 16sc, (3sc, dec) x 9 times, 16sc (68)  
**Round 91-93:** 68sc (68)  
**Round 94:** 8sc, (2sc, dec) x 13 times, 8sc (55)  
**Round 95-97:** 55sc (55)  
**Round 98:** 5sc, (3sc, dec) x 9times, 5sc (46)  
**Round 99-100:** 46sc (46)

Put in fiber

**TIP 3:** do not put fiber too much and try to make it even all around the body.

Be sure that there is enough fiber in the muzzle (put it here as much as possible). Muzzle has to be stuffed very heavy.

**Round 101:** 5sc, (2sc, dec) x 9times, 5sc (37)  
**Round 102:** 37sc (37)  
**Round 103:** 5sc, (1sc, dec) x 9times, 5sc (28)  
**Round 104:** 28sc (28)  
**Round 105:** (5sc, dec) x 4times (24)  
**Round 106-107:** 24sc (24)  
**Round 108:** 8sc, (inc) x 8times, 8 (32)  
**Round 109:** 32sc (32)  
**Round 110:** (2dc together) x 4times, 16sc, (2dc together) x 4times (24)  
**Round 111:** 24sc (24)  
**Round 112:** 8sc, (inc) x 8times, 8 (32)  
**Round 113:** 32sc (32)  
**Round 114:** (2dc together) x 4times, 16sc, (2dc together) x 4times (24)  
**Round 115:** 2dc together, 6dc, 8sc, 6dc, 2dc together (22)  
**Round 116:** 7dc, (inc) x 8times, 7dc (30)  
**Round 117:** (2dc together) x 4 times, 14sc, (2dc together) x 4 times, (22)  
**Round 118:** 7dc, (inc) x 8times, 7dc (30)  
**Round 119:** (2dc together) x 4 times, 14sc, (2dc together) x 4 times, (22)  
**Round 120:** 7dc, (inc) x 8times, 7dc (30)  
**Round 121:** (2dc together) x 4 times, 14sc, (2dc together) x 4 times, (22)  
**Round 122-123:** 8dc, 6sc, 8dc (22)  
**Round 124:** (2sc together), 18sc, (2sc together), (20)  
**Round 125-128:** 20sc (20) **put in fiber**  
**Round 129-130:** put in fiber and make sc together to finish a tail.

**Back legs (make two)**

In amigurumi ring make 6 sc

**Round 1:** (inc) x 6 times (12)

**Round 2:** (1sc, inc) x 6 times (18)

**Round 3:** (2sc, inc) x 6 times (24)

**Round 4:** (3sc, inc) x 6 times (30)

**Round 5-11:** 30sc (30)

**Round 12:** (4sc, dec) x 5 times (25)

Put in fiber

**Round 13-20:** 25sc (25)

**Round 21:** 12sc, inc, 11sc, inc (27)

**Round 22-26:** 27sc (27)

**Round 27:** 12sc, inc, 13sc, inc (29)

**Round 28-32:** 29sc (29) **put in fiber**

**Round 33-34:** make sc together to finish a leg

Sew legs together with body



We have to make front legs closer, insert yarn like on picture and tie a knot. Ends of yarn hide into a toy.

**TIP 4:** put one drop of super glue on knot if you use some “silky” yarn.





Lets make dog's muzzle:

**TIP 5:** do not cut end's of yarn – hide its into a toy

Lets put eyes on right place. Insert yarn like on the picture; make a knot, tight it pretty strong

Make his head little narrow. Insert yarn like on the picture; make a knot, tight it pretty strong

and we have to finish all legs. Make fingers by yarn. Insert yarn like on the picture; make a knot, tight it pretty strong after each finger is made.



Make from oven-bake clay nose, bake it in oven (instruction how to bake it is written on clay) and use gorilla glue to attach it on the muzzle.
