

CROCHET PATTERN



THE REQUIRED MATERIALS AND TOOLS.

The required yarn:

YarnArt «JEANS»(55% cotton, 45% acrylic, 50 gr / 160 m)

The basic colors: color 46 – grey, 49 – bright grey

81 – bright turquoise for the nose. Choose the color of your taste.

Use different yarn of similar composition as desired.



Colors 35 yellow and 69 green for making the scarf.



Iris PNK named after S.M. Kirov (100% mercerized cotton, 25g, 150m) of dark grey color for embroidering mouth and whiskers.



2 mm crochet hook Clover

Stuffing material, fiberfill.

D=4 mm safety eyes (sewing eyes or embroider the eyes)

Tapestry needle.



Terms and abbreviations (US):

Ch - chain

MR –magic ring

Sc – single crochet

DC – double crochet

Sl st – slip stitch

inc – increase – two single crochet in one stitch

dec – decrease – two single crochet together

(...) x 6 times – repeat (or other number) as instructed

(*) – number of stitches in the round

LEGS (make 2).

Start working with grey color 46 yarn.

1 row – 8 ch, start working into the 2nd st from hook sc, 5 sc, 3 sc into the last st, continue working on the opposite side of the chain: 5 sc, inc into the last st. (16)



2 row – inc, 5 sc, 3 inc, 5 sc, 2 inc. (22)

3 row – 1 sc, inc, 5 sc, (1 sc, inc)x3, 5 sc, (1 sc, inc)x2 (28)

4 row – 2 sc, inc, 5 sc, (2 sc, inc)x3, 5 sc, (2 sc, inc)x2 (34)

5 row – 3 sc, inc, 5 sc, (3 sc, inc)x3, 5 sc, (3 sc, inc)x2 (40)



6 row – 40 sc (40)

7 row – 12 sc, (dec, 3 sc)x3, 11 sc, dec. (36)

8 row – 36 sc (36)

9 row – 12 sc, (dec, 2 sc)x3, 12 sc (33)

10 row – 33 sc (33)

11 row - 12 sc, (dec, 1 sc)x3, 12 sc (30)



12 rpw – 9 sc, 6 dec, 9 sc (24)

13 row - 9 sc, 3 dec, 9 sc (21)

14 row – switch the color, 21 sc through back loops only. (21)

Stuff the toe.



15 row – 21 sc (21)

16 row – 21 sc (21)

17 row – 21 sc (21)

18 row – 21 sc (21)

19 row – 21 sc (21)

20 row – switch the color, 21 sc (21)

21 row – 21 sc (21)

22 row – switch the color, 21 sc (21)

23 row – 21 sc (21)

24 row – switch the color, 21 sc (21)

25 row – 21 sc (21)

26 row – switch the color, 21 sc (21)

27 row – 21 sc (21)

28 row – 21 sc (21)

29 row – 21 sc (21)

30 row – 21 sc (21)

31 row – 21 sc (21)

32 row – 21 sc (21)

Sl st at the left leg, fasten off and cut yarn.

Do not cut the yarn of the right leg and continue working the body.

Stuff the toe with fiberfill firmly and stuff the leg until the 27 row.



Fold the top of the right leg and sew the 10th sc.



The toe must look to the side (to the left). It could be possible that you will add or decrease sc in the 32 row.



Chain 3, fold the top of the left leg so that the toe looks to the right and sew the 10th sc.





Turn and place with front facing you.



Start working the body.

1 row – ch, 10 sc through FLO of the left leg, 3 sc along the chain, 10 sc through FLO of the right leg, along the opposite side of the chain: work through the remaining loops, inc, 9 sc along the right leg, 3 sc along the chain, 9 sc along the left leg, inc. (48)



2 row – inc, 21 sc, 3 inc, 21 sc, 2 inc.

(54)

3 row – (8 sc, inc)x6

(60)

4-12 rows – 60 sc (9 rows)



13 row – (8 sc, dec)x6 (54)

14-22 rows – 54 sc (9 rows)

23 row – (7 sc, dec)x6 (48)

24 row – 48 sc (48)

25 row – 48 sc (48)

26 row – (6 sc, dec)x6 (42)

27 row – 42 sc (42)

28 row – 42 sc (42)

29 row – (5 sc, dec)x6 (36)

Start stuffing the body.



- 30 row – (4 sc, dec)x6 (30)
31 row – (3 sc, dec)x6 (24)
32 row – (2 sc, dec)x6 (18)
33 row- 18 sc (18)
34 row- 18 sc (18)
35 row- 18 sc (18) Stuff the neck with fiberfill firmly
36 row – (1 sc, dec)x6 (12)
37 row – 6 dec
Fasten off, and hide the tail inside.



HEAD

Put safety eyes between the 12 and 13 rows.

1 row – 6 sc into MR	(6)
2 row – 6 inc	(12)
3 row – (1 sc, inc)x6	(18)
4 row – (2 sc, inc)x6	(24)
5 row – (3 sc, inc)x6	(30)
6 row – (4 sc, inc)x6	(36)
7 row – (5 sc, inc)x6	(42)
8 row – (6 sc, inc)x6	(48)
9 row – (7 sc, inc)x6	(54)

10 row – (8 sc, inc)x6	(60)
11 row – (9 sc, inc)x6	(66)
12 row – (10 sc, inc)x6	(72)
13 row – (11 sc, inc)x6	(78)
14-22 rows – 78 sc (9 rows)	
23 row – (11 sc, dec)x6	(72)
24 row – (10 sc, dec)x6	(66)
25 row – (9 sc, dec)x6	(60)
26 row – (8 sc, dec)x6	(54)
27 row – (7 sc, dec)x6	(48)
28 row – (6 sc, dec)x6	(42)
29 row – (5 sc, dec)x6	(36)
30 row – (4 sc, dec)x6	(30) Stuff the head with fiberfill
31 row – (3 sc, dec)x6	(24)
32 row – (2 sc, dec)x6, sl st	(18)

Fasten off, cut yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.



ARMS (make 2).

1 row – 6 sc into MR	(6)
2 row – 6 inc	(12)
3 row – (1 sc, inc)x6	(18)
4 row – 18 sc	(18)

- 5 row – 18 sc (18)
- 6 row – 18 sc (18)
- 7 row – 18 sc (18)
- 8 row – (4 sc, dec)x3 (15)
- 9 row – 15 sc (15) Stuff the paw with fiberfill
- 10 row – switch the color, 15 sc (15)



- 11 row – 15 sc (15)
- 12 row – 15 sc (15)
- 13 row – 15 sc (15)
- 14 row – 15 sc (15)
- 15 row – 15 sc (15)
- 16 row – 15 sc (15)
- 17 row – switch the color, 15 sc (15)
- 18 row – 15 sc (15)



- 19 row – switch the color, 15 sc (15)
- 20 row – 15 sc (15)
- 21 row – switch the color, 15 sc (15)
- 22 row – 15 sc (15)
- 23 row – switch the color, 15 sc (15)
- 24 row – 15 sc (15)

- 25 row – switch the color, 15 sc (15)
- 26 row – 15 sc (15)
- 27 row – switch the color, 15 sc (15)
- 28 row – 15 sc (15) Stuff with fiberfill gently until the 19 row.
- 29 row – (3 sc, dec)x3 (12)
- 30 row – 12 sc (12)
- 31 row – 12 sc (12)
- 32 row – 12 sc (12)

Fold the paw and sew the 5th sc, t-ch, turn, 5 sc, t-ch, turn, 5 sc.

Fasten off, cut yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.



Make the second arm similarly.



TAIL.

1 row – 6 sc into MR	(6)
2 row – 6 inc	(12)
3 row – 12 sc	(12)
4 row – 12 sc	(12)
5 row – 12 sc	(12)
6 row – 12 sc	(12)
7 row – 12 sc	(12)
8 row – 12 sc	(12)
9 row – 12 sc	(12)
10 row – switch the color, 12 sc	(12)
11 row – 12 sc	(12)
12 row – 12 sc	(12)
13 row – 12 sc	(12)

- 14row – switch the color, 12 sc (12)
15row – 12 sc (12)
16row – switch the color, 12 sc (12)
17row – 12 sc (12)
18row – switch the color, 12 sc (12)
19row – 12 sc (12)
20row – switch the color, 12 sc (12)
21row – 12 sc (12)
22row – switch the color, 12 sc (12)
23row – 12 sc (12)
24row – switch the color, 12 sc (12)
25-42rows – 12 sc (18 rows)

Fold the tail and sew the 5th sc.

Fasten off, and cut yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.



EARS (make 2).

1 row – 6 sc into MR

2row – 6 sc (6)

3row – 6 inc (12)

4row – 12 sc (12)

5row – (1 sc, inc)x6 (18)

6row – 18 sc (18)

7row – (2 sc, inc)x6 (24)

8row – 24 sc (24)

9row – 24 sc (24)

Fasten off, and cut yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.

Make the second ear similarly.



NOSE.

Chain 5, start working into the 3rd st from hook 2 DC, DC, 4 DC into the last st, continue working along the other side of chain: DC, 2 DC into the last st, sl st into the first DC.

Pull the yarn, and cut leaving a long tail for sewing.



ASSEMBLY.

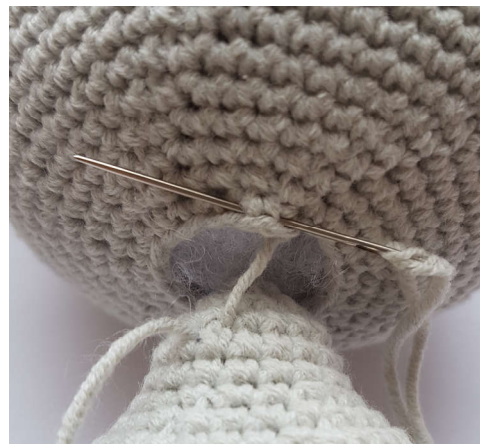
Sew the head to the body.

Mark the outline of the head on the neck with pins first so that you have a guide when sewing. (Between the 3 and 4 rows from the end of the crocheting).

It is indicated in the photo below.



Insert the needle between the 3 and 4 rows of the neck and sew through the loops of the head in the last row. Continue sewing through the loops to the end.





Sew the ears.

Attach the ears with pins to the head.



First, sew through the front loops and then through the back loops of the ear.





Sew the second ear similarly.



Sew the nose.

Put the nose on the muzzle. The upper edge of the nose must be between the 13 and 14 rows. Sew it to the muzzle.



Glue the eyes (you may sew the eye beads or embroider the eyes).



Embroider the mouth and whiskers.

Thread the needle and tie a knot.



Insert the needle and draw to the bottom edge of the nose.

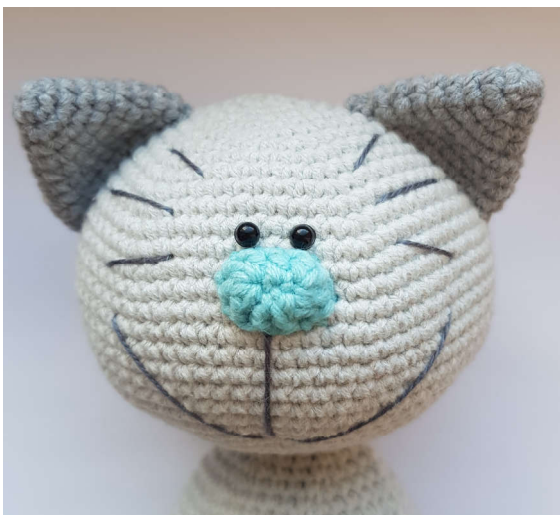


Hide the knot inside.



Embroider the mouth and whiskers.





Sew the arms.

Position the place where you will attach the arms (I placed them between the 4 and 5 rows if you count from the sewing place of the head).

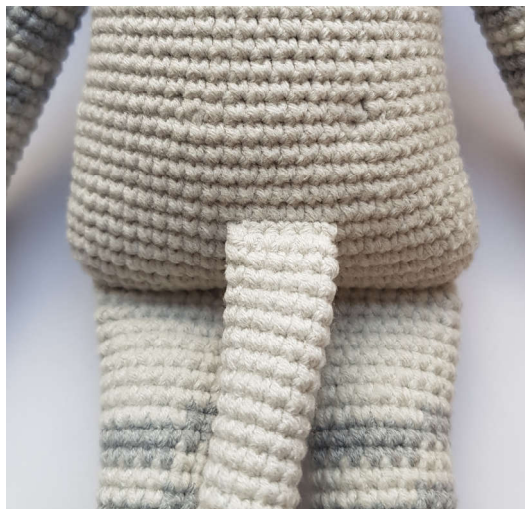


Sew them to the body.





Sew the tail to the body.



Our cat is ready!

SCARF

Chain until you reach 24.8/25.5 inches/63-65 cm (I chained 210) and 3 t-ch. Work 2 rows in DC.

1 row – 213 ch, start working into the 4th st from hook 210 DC

2 row – switch the color, 3 t-ch, 210 DC.

Fasten off, cut yarn, and hide the tails.
