### Materials:

1. Yarn (Weight: fingering or super fine yarn)
  - Beige (Hands and head)
  - Blue (body)
  - Yellow or any other color (dummy)
  - Black (brow)
  - Brown (hair)
2. Hook 1,3
3. Fiberfill
4. Yarn or tapestry needle
5. Pieces of black felt for eyes

### Terms Used:

sl st - slip stitch  
ch - chain  
sc - single crochet  
inc - increase  
dec - decrease  
hdc - half double crochet  
dc - double crochet  
sc3tog - stitch next 3 stitches together  
BLO - Back Loop Only  
FLO - Front Loop Only  
( ) - number of stitches for each round  
FO - Finish off  
[ ] - repeat work as directed  
\*- indicates repeats

### Important:

- All rounds are worked in a continuous spiral, unless instructed otherwise
- Use a stitchmarker for counting your rounds
- If you prefer to sew parts together, leave a long tail after you finish off. I think the toy looks neater if you sew with a finer yarn. (For example, a separate piece of thread from the yarn you crocheted with)
- It is easier if you add your fiberfill to all the pieces as you are crocheting them

## Let's go:

### Hands

#### With beige

Make 2

4 ch

Round 1) starting in second stitch from hook 2 sc, 3 sc in the first loop of the chain, now working on the other side of the chain sc, inc (8)

Round 2) 8 sc (8)

Round 3) [inc, 3 sc] \* 2 (10)

Round 4) 10 sc (10)

Round 5) 10 sl st (10)

#### With blue

Round 6) [4 sc, inc] \* 2 (12)

Round 7) [sc, inc] \* 6 (18)

Round 8-15) 18 sc (18) FO



### Legs

#### With blue

6 ch

Round 1) starting in second stitch from hook 4 sc, 3 sc in the first loop of the chain, now working on the other side of the chain 3 sc, inc (12)

Round 2) inc, 3 sc, 3 inc, 3 sc, 2 inc (18)

Round 3) inc, 4 sc, [inc, sc] \* 3, 3 sc, [inc, sc] \* 2 (24)

Round 4-6) 24 sc (24)

Round 7) 9 sc, 3 dec, 9 sc (21)

Round 8) dec, 5 sc, dec, sc3tog, dec, 5 sc, dec (15)

Round 9) 15 sc (15)

Round 10) [4 sc, inc] \* 3 (18)

Round 11) [2 sc, inc] \* 6 (24)

Round 12-14) 24 sc (24)

Do NOT cut yarn after second leg continue on with body instructions



## Body

With blue



Mark 1 stitch on the inner side of each leg. This is the place of legs connection

Round 15) 21 sc, 24 sc on other leg, 3 sc on first leg (48)

Round 16) [7 sc, inc] \* 6 (54)

Round 17-24) 54 sc (54)

Round 25) [7 sc, dec] \* 6 (48)

Round 26) 3 sc, [dec, 6 sc] \* 5, dec, 3 sc (42)

Round 27) 42 sc (42)

Round 28) [dec, 5 sc] \* 6 (36)

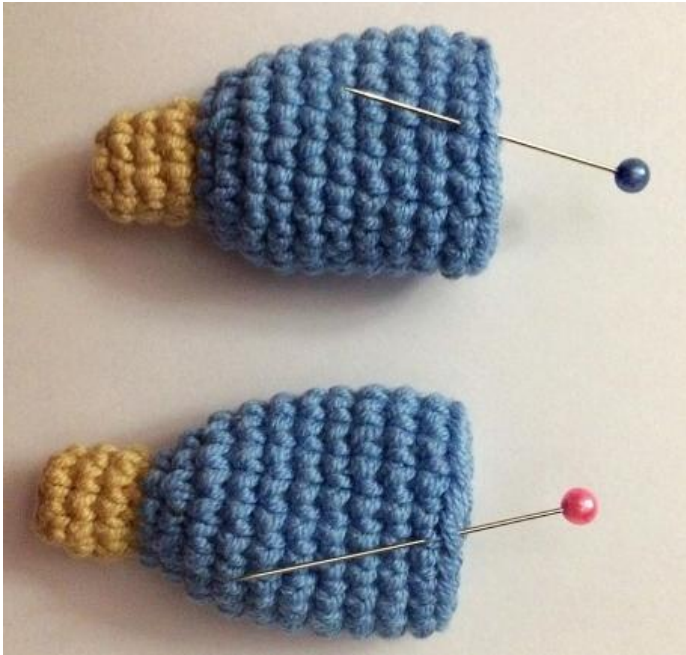
Round 29) 36 sc (36)

Round 30) [4 sc, dec] \* 6 (30)

Round 31) 30 sc (30)

For round 32 we will be attaching the arms

Mark 1 stitch on the inner side of each hand



Round 32) 7 sc, 18 sc on left hand, 16 sc, 18 sc on right hand, 7 sc (66)

Round 33) [9 sc, dec] \* 6 (60)

Round 34) 4 sc, [dec, 8 sc] \* 5, dec, 4 sc (54)

Round 35) [dec, 7 sc] \* 6 (48)

Round 36) 3 sc, [dec, 6 sc] \* 5, dec, 3 sc (42)

Round 37) [5 sc, dec] \* 6 (36)

Round 38) 2 sc, [dec, 4 sc] \* 5, dec, 2 sc (30)

With beige

Round 39) [4 sc, inc] \* 6 in FLO(36)

Round 40) 3 sc, [inc, 5 sc] \* 5, inc, 2 sc (42)

Round 41) [inc, 6 sc] \* 6 (48)

Round 42) 4 sc, [inc, 7 sc] \* 5, inc, 3 sc (54)  
Round 43) [8 sc, inc] \* 6 (60)  
Round 44) 5 sc, [inc, 9 sc] \* 5, inc, 4 sc (66)  
Round 45) [inc, 10 sc] \* 6 (72)  
Round 46) 72 sc (72)  
Round 47) [inc, 11 sc] \* 6 (78)  
Round 48) 6 sc, [inc, 12 sc] \* 5, inc, 6 sc (84)  
Round 49-59) 84 sc (84)  
Round 60) 6 sc, [dec, 12 sc] \* 5, dec, 6 sc (78)  
Round 61) [11 sc, dec] \* 6 (72)  
Round 62) 5 sc, [dec, 10 sc] \* 5, dec, 5 sc (66)  
Round 63) 66 sc (66)  
Round 64) [9 sc, dec] \* 6 (60)  
Round 65) 4 sc, [dec, 8 sc] \* 5, dec, 4 sc (54)  
Round 66) [dec, 7 sc] \* 6 (48)  
Round 67) 3 sc, [dec, 6 sc] \* 5, dec, 3 sc (42)  
Round 68) 42 sc (42)  
Round 69) [5 sc, dec] \* 6 (36)  
Round 70) 2 sc, [dec, 4 sc] \* 5, dec, 2 sc (30)  
Round 71) [dec, 3 sc] \* 6 (24)  
Round 72) sc, [dec, 2 sc] \* 5, dec, sc (18)  
Round 73) [sc, dec] \* 6 (12)  
Round 74) 6 dec (6) FO



## Ears

### With beige

Round 1) 6 sc into magic ring (6)  
Round 2) 6 inc (12)  
Round 3) [sc, inc] \* 6 (18)

Round 4) 18 sl st (18) FO

## Dummy

With yellow

Center

Round 1) 6 sc into magic ring (6)

Round 2) 6 inc (12)

Round 3) 12 sc in BLO (12)

Round 4) 12 sc (12)

Main part

7 ch

Round 1) starting in second stitch from hook. 4 sc, 3 sc in the first loop of the chain, now working on the other side of the chain 3 sc, inc (12)

Round 2) inc, 3 sc, 3 inc, 3 sc, 2 inc (18)

Round 3) inc, 4 sc, [inc, sc] \* 3, 3 sc, [inc, sc] \* 2 (24)

Round 4) only 13 stitches in this round: sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc, 2 hdc, 2 dc, 2 hdc, sc, sl st (13)

Ring

22 ch

Round 1) 22 sc (22)

Sew together the pieces dummy

## Hair

With brown

Using the latch hook method for join 10-12 peace of yarn



## Face

Sew ears – round 52-54

Embroider nose – round 52

Glue eyes – 53-55 round

Embroider brow – 58 round

Sew dummy – 44-50 round
