

Pattern Mouse Fiep



Material

Approx 25 grams Phildar Coton 3 or Catania

2,5 mm crochet hook

6 mm black safety eyes 2

Synthetic filling

If necessary felt for the spots

Used stitches

ch = chain

sl.st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

sc2tog = single crochet two

stitches together

This is a basic pattern.

You can make stripes at your discretion.

Crochet the ears for example with stripes and use narrow or wide stripes or sew spots on the body.

Just vary and you can make another mouse each time!

BODY

You are starting with the nose.

Crochet 2ch

1. 6sc in the last chain from the hook
2. 1sc, 2sc in the next sc, repeat (9sc)
3. 2sc, 2sc in the next sc, repeat (12sc)
- 4-5. 12sc
6. 2sc, sc2tog, repeat (9sc)

Change color!

7. 2sc, 2sc in the next sc, repeat (12sc)
8. 12sc
9. 3sc, 2sc in the next sc, repeat (15sc)
10. 4sc, 2sc in the next sc, repeat (18sc)
11. 18sc
12. 5sc, 2sc in the next sc, repeat (21sc)
13. 21sc
14. 6sc, 2sc in the next sc, repeat (24sc)
15. 24sc
16. 3sc, 2sc in the next sc, repeat (30sc)

Place the eyes between row 12 and row 13 with 4sc spacing.

17-36. 30sc

37. 3sc, sc2tog, repeat (24sc)

Fill the body.

38. 2sc, sc2tog, repeat (18sc)

39. 1sc, sc2tog, repeat (12sc)

Fill the body completely..

40. sc2tog, repeat (6sc)

Close the body.

EAR (MAKE 2)

Crochet 2ch

1. 6sc in the last chain from the hook

2. 2sc in each sc, repeat (12sc)

3. 1sc, 2sc in the next sc, repeat (18sc)

4-8. 18sc

Fold the ear and close it with 9sc.

Sew the ears between row 16 and row 17 with 2sc spacing on the body.

TAIL

Crochet 40ch and turn 40sc on this chain.

Sew the tail on the body.

Sew spots of feld on the body.

Sew two whiskers on both sides of the snout.
