

**Materials:**

1. Crochet hook - size 10
2. Crochet thread (Aunt Lydia's) - size 10
3. Scissors
4. Sewing needle

**Notes:**

1. When forming the magic ring, leave a long tail. We'll use that to make the mouse tail later.

**Pattern:**

Mr, ch 1, sc 8

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each – 16

Rnd 2: 1 sc, 2 sc – 24

Rnd 3: 1 sc, 1 sc, 2 sc – 32

Rnd 4: 1 sc, 1 sc, 1 sc, 2 sc – 40

Rnds 5 – 9: sc around – 40

Rnd 10: 1 sc, 1 sc, 1 sc, sc2tog – 32

Rnd 11: sc around

Rnd 12: 1 sc, 1 sc, sc2tog – 24

Rnd 13 - 14: sc around

Sew the eyes on round 14, 5 sts apart

Rnd 15: 1 sc, 1 sc, 1 sc, 1 sc, sc2tog – 20

Rnd 16: sc around

Stuff the body well.

Rnd 17: 1 sc, 1 sc, 1 sc, sc2tog – 16

Rnd 18: 1 sc, 1 sc, sc 2 tog – 12

Stuff more if needed before finishing rnd 19.

Rnd 19: sc 2 tog – 6

Fasten off. Leave a long tail. Bring it all the way through the body of the mouse and through the magic ring.

**Ears (x 2):**

Leave long tails. After you sew the ears in place, you will bring the tails through the magic ring.

Mr, ch 1, sc 8

Rnd 1: 2 hdc in each

Rnd 2: sc around

Pull and sew in place.

**Tail:**

You should have 6 pieces of long thread coming out of the magic ring. Braid those until you reach a desired length for the tail. Make a not and cut the rest.
