Materials

Size H (5.0mm) Crochet Hook

Worsted Weight Yarn in colors for main cloud, cheeks, and (optional) bow

Pair of 18mm Black Safety Eyes

Poly-fil Stuffing

Tapestry Needle

Abbreviations

Ch – Chain
 SC – Single Crochet
 DC – Double Crochet
 Dec – Single Crochet Decrease
 Inc – Single Crochet Increase
 FO – Fasten Off
 MR – Magic Ring
 Sl St – Slip Stitch

Cloud Body

Make 2.

{Starting on the left side and working across the cloud}

At the end of each Row, you will turn and Ch1.

Row 1 – With yarn choice for main cloud, ch11, SC into 2nd Ch from hook and in each Ch across. (10)
 Row 2 – Inc, SC8, Inc. (12)
 Row 3 – Inc, SC10, Inc. (14)
 Row 4 – Inc, SC12, Inc (16)
 Row 5 – Inc, SC14, Inc (18)
 Row 6 – Inc, SC16, Inc (20)
 Row 7 – Inc, SC18, Inc (22)
 Rows 8-10 – SC across (22)
 Row 11 – Inc, SC20, Inc (24)
 Row 12 – Inc, SC22, Inc (26)
 Row 13 – Inc, SC24, Inc (28)
 Row 14 – Inc, SC26, Inc (30)
 Row 15 – Inc, SC28, Inc (32)
 Row 16 – Inc, SC30, Inc (34)
 Rows 17-20 – SC across (34)
 Row 21 – Dec, SC30, Dec (32)
 Row 22 – Dec, SC28, Dec (30)
 Row 23 – Dec, SC26, Dec (28)
 Row 24 – Inc, SC26, Inc (30)
 Row 25 – Inc, SC28, Inc (32)
 Row 26 – Inc, SC30, Inc (34)
 Row 27 – Inc, SC32, Inc (36)
 Row 28 – Inc, SC34, Inc (38)
 Row 29 – Inc, SC36, Inc (40)
 Row 30 – Inc, SC38, Inc (42)
 Row 31 – Inc, SC40, Inc (44)
 Rows 32-34 – SC across (44)
 Row 35 – Dec, SC40, Dec (42)
 Row 36 – Dec, SC38, Dec (40)
 Row 37 – Dec, SC36, Dec (38)
 Row 38 – Dec, SC34, Dec (36)
 Row 39 – Dec, SC32, Dec (34)
 Row 40 – Dec, SC30, Dec (32)
 Row 41 – Dec, SC28, Dec (30)
 Row 42 – Dec, SC26, Dec (28)
 Row 43 – Inc, SC26, Inc (30)
 Row 44 – Inc, SC28, Inc (32)
 Row 45 – Inc, SC30, Inc (34)
 Rows 46-49 – SC across (34)
 Row 50 – Dec, SC30, Dec (32)
 Row 51 – Dec, SC28, Dec (30)
 Row 52 – Dec, SC26, Dec (28)
 Row 53 – Dec, SC24, Dec (26)
 Row 54 – Dec, SC22, Dec (24)
 Row 55 – Dec, SC20, Dec (22)

Rows 56-58 – SC across (22)
 Row 59 – Dec, SC18, Dec (20)
 Row 60 – Dec, SC16, Dec (18)
 Row 61 – Dec, SC14, Dec (16)
 Row 62 – Dec, SC12, Dec (14)
 Row 63 – Dec, SC10, Dec (12)
 Row 64 – Dec, SC8, Dec (10)
 FO, weave in ends

Cheeks

{Cheeks are worked in a continuous round, do not join}

Make 2.

Round 1 – MR, 6SC (6)

Round 2 – Inc x 6 (12)

Round 3 – SC, Inc (18)

Round 4 – SC (18)

FO, weave in ends

The Bow (optional)

Start with MR, crochet the following stitches into the center- Ch3, 3DC, Ch3, 1 sl st, Ch3, 3DC, Ch3, 1 sl st. Pull the ring together. FO, leaving long tail. Wrap yarn tail around middle of bow a few times and tie off on back.

Alternative to Safety Eyes

{Eyes are worked in a continuous round, do not join}

Make 2.

Round 1 – MR, 6SC (6)

Round 2 – Inc x 6 (12)

FO, weave in ends

You can also embroidery or use puff paint to create sleepy eyes like this:



Assembly

Place safety eyes roughly ten stitches from the top of the cloud, ten rows apart.

Sew or glue cheeks & bow in place.

Align cloud halves so ends of rows match. With wrong sides facing each other, single crochet around both pieces to join together. Stuff with Poly-Fil prior to completing stitching. Make sure you work in an anti-clockwise direction so your stitches face forward.

My finished Cloud Kawaii Cuddler is 10" x 14". Hook size, yarn choice, and crochet tension will affect each individual result.
