Join yarn A on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the 2<sup>nd</sup> rnd of the Body and continue crocheting \*ch 3, slst 1 on the next st\* in the flo of rnd 2-17 (see Assembling Part). Remember to change the color to create the color stripes for the Spider.

## ASSEMBLING

Crochet the body & head as instructed



Stuff gradually while crocheting



Stop when you finish crochet rnd 27 of the Head



Crochet 2 eyes as instructed



Insert black safety eye 6mm into the eye



Insert black safety eye 6mm into the eye



Insert the eyes between rnd 26 & 27 of the head



Put the eye lids on



Crochet the last rnd of the head



Use the tapestry needle to weave in the last 6 sts



Hide the remaining yarn



Use the tapestry needle to sew 2 eyes on the head



## ASSEMBLING

Hide the remaining yarn



Join yarn A on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the 2<sup>nd</sup> rnd of the Body



Crocheting \*ch 3, slst 1 on the next st\* on the remaining loop of rnd 2-17



Remember to change the color to create the stripes for the Spider



Crochet the pumpkin's hat as instructed



Sew the hat on the head



Attach the 1st legs as below photo

Sew the body to the head



Sew inner and outer wings together with a button (or you can sew with just thread if you do not need the wings to move)



Continue to sew the button to the body



Pull through 3 layers (inner wing, outer wing, body) 2-3 times



The wings can be moveable thanks to the button



Use black thread to sew the mouth, the pink thread to sew the cheeks



Sew the buttons on the overalls

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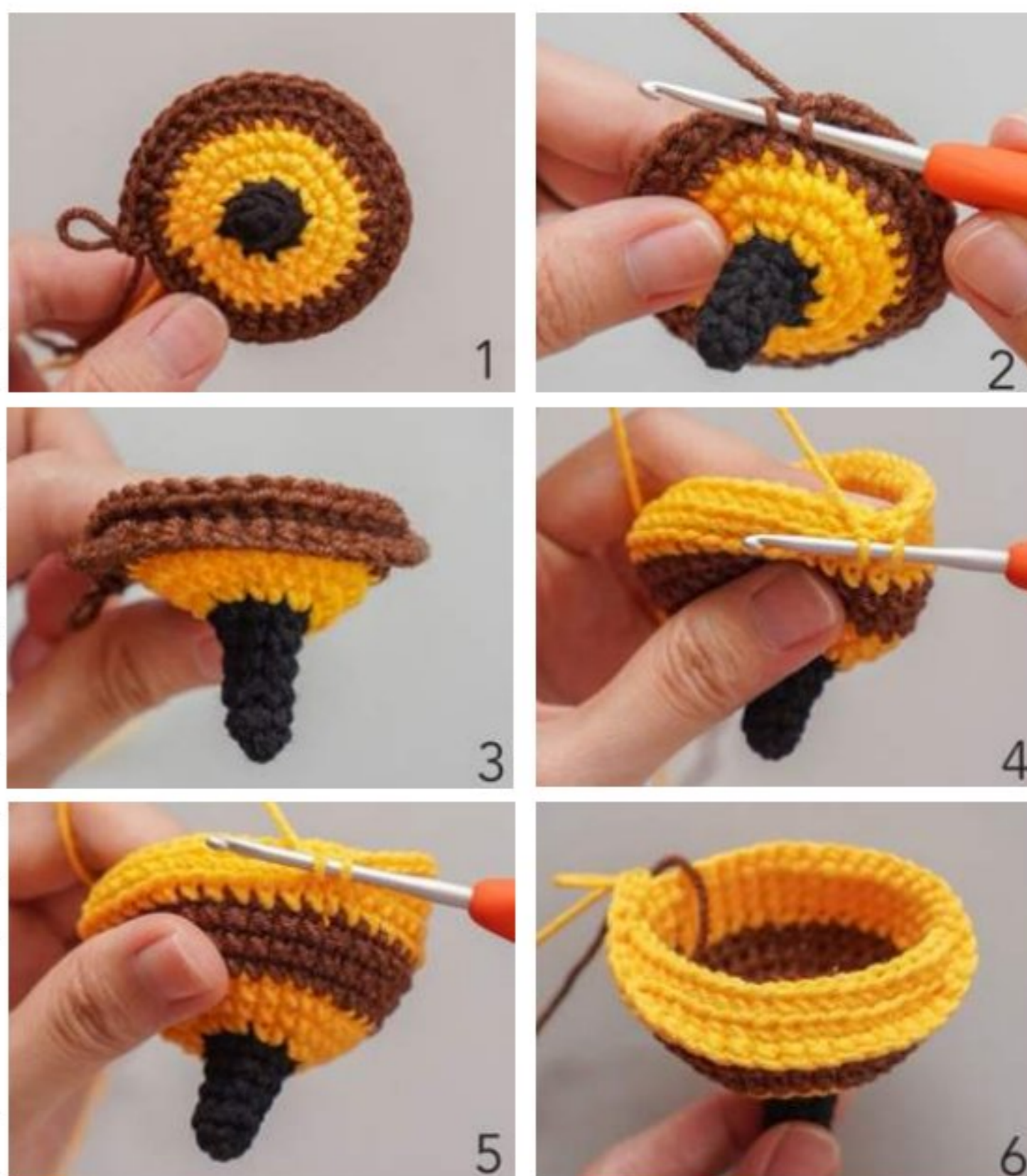

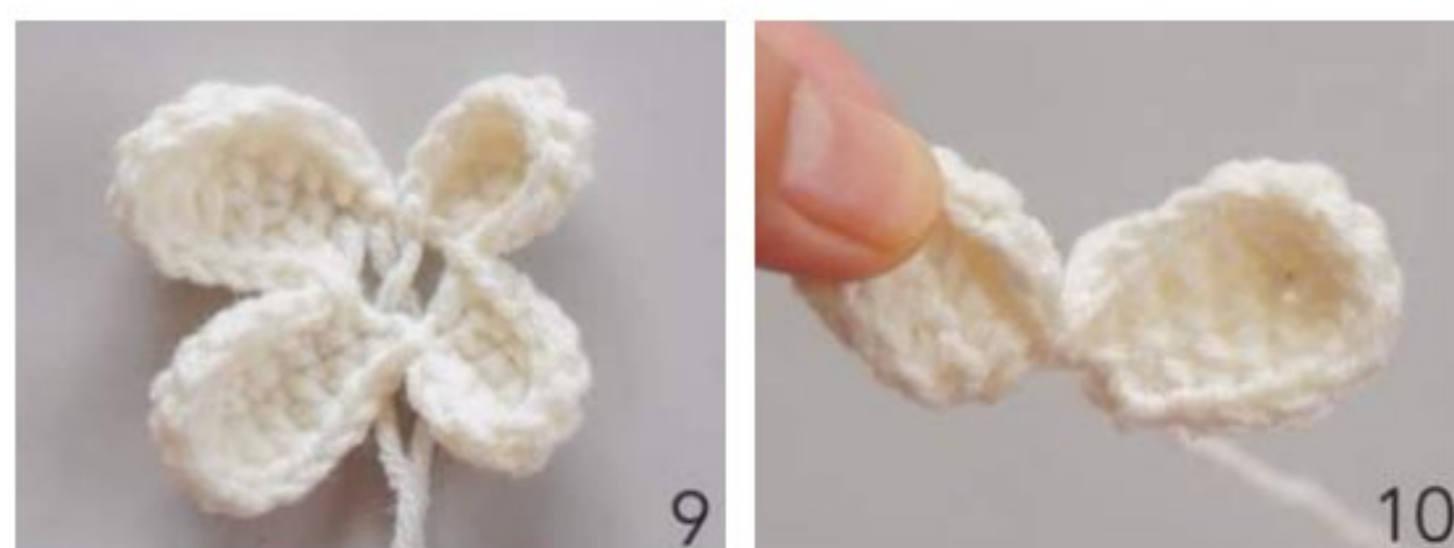
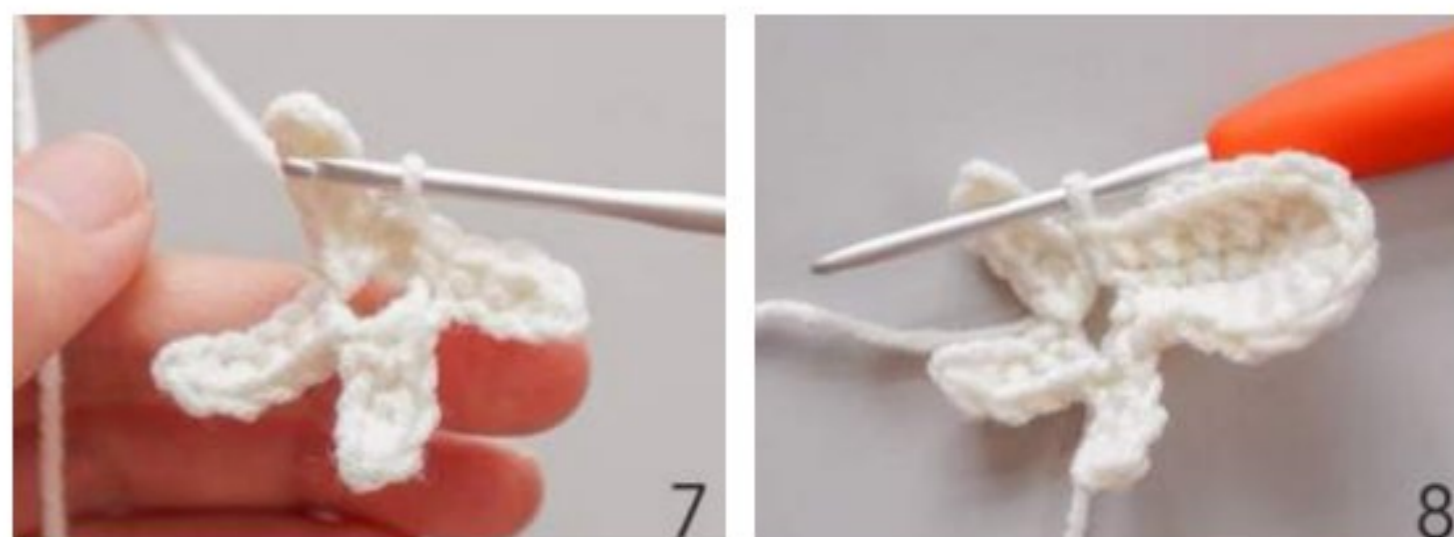

This is the finished body as instructed



Insert 6mm safety eyes into the middle of the eye, sew to the yellow part (remember to place the thin stripe upward)



Sew the eyelids above the eyes



Sew the antennas 3 rnds above the eyes



Use black thread to sew eyebrows, mouth and pink thread to sew the cheeks



Sew the wing to the body

Sew 3 legs on 1 side as below photo



Sew 3 remaining legs to the other side

## CROCHETING TIPS

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### 1. What is X-shape stitch/V-shape stitch? Which one is better?

X-shape stitch or V-shape stitch depends on the way you pull the yarn through the loop. If you yarn over the hook from back to front, you're making a V-shape stitch. If you yarn under the hook, then it's a X-shape stitch. Both ways are fine, you can crochet whichever you find easier.

V-shape stitch helps your amigurumi look bigger, while X-shape stitch makes your amigurumi more beautiful and helps to make the amigurumi tighter.

### 2. Right side vs wrong side? Which one is correct?

You can see the difference between the right side and wrong side in the photos bellow.

When you crochet mini-sized toys/dolls, it is unable to turn the sides. Therefore, it is normal having the wrong side out.

### 3. Hide the yarn

For the remaining yarn, you can use a tapestry needle and weave it vertically through stitches. Repeat a couple times to make sure it stays firmly.

### 5. How to change the yarn color correctly?

Before changing the yarn color, there are two loops on the hook.



Take the yarn (you want to change) through both loop.



Change the color as instructed.

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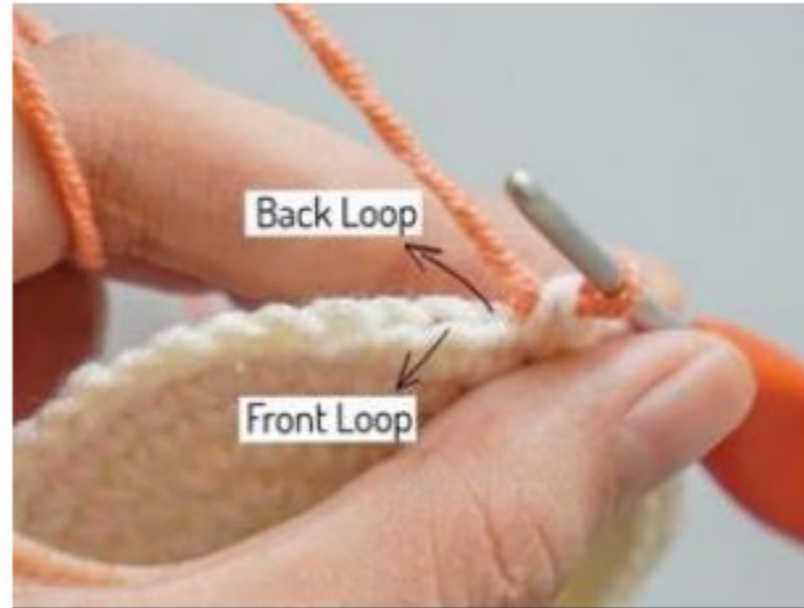
### 6. Invisible Decrease

Normal decrease (photo bellow) will make a large hole, so we should use invisible decrease. Just crochet on front loop only.

### 7. Weave in the remaining 6 sts on the last rnd
